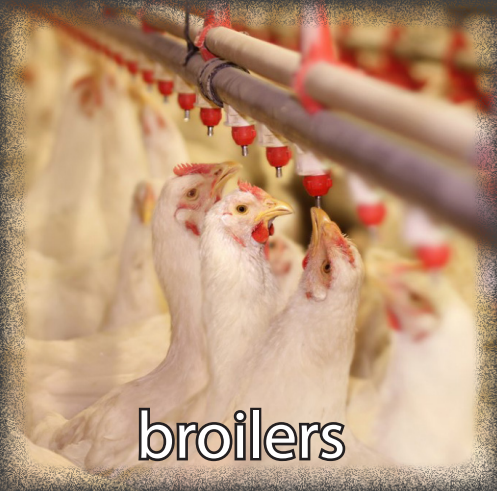

FEES:

\$845 – Full registration includes the 4-part Poultry 201 online course, 3-day training course, classroom materials, and site visits. Pending approval, your registration acceptance will be emailed to you by PAACO along with instructions for the prerequisites and course information.

CONTINUING EDUCATION:
